## ADULT PAR 3 PLAYER GUIDELINES FOR WEEKLY PLAY

**SIGNING UP TO PLAY:** An email will be sent out every Wednesday at approximately 2:00 PM with the Golf Genius link required to sign up for the following week. Please retain the confirmation email, as it contains the link you will need if you wish to make changes. Should you require a change or cancellation after 3:00 P.M. on Tuesday or the morning of play, please contact the Sykes Lady OP Pro Shop at 913-890-1600.

**Tee Times:** Tee times will be scheduled between 8:00 AM and 10:00 AM on Wednesday and Thursday mornings. Tee times at 7:30 AM will be available during the summer months.

**Lunch:** The league will host luncheons after each of the two tournaments. If you intend to attend the luncheon or participate in the tournament, you must register in advance on Golf Genius. An email will be sent to all participants to initiate the signup process several weeks prior to the tournament. This is necessary to obtain a final count for the luncheon and tournament a week before the event.

**Lunch Registration:** When registering for the luncheon, please pay for your lunch via Venmo or check payable to “OP Par 3 Golf” by the specified deadline. There are no refunds. If you have not paid by a week before the tournament your spot will go to someone on the waitlist.

# PLAYING THE GAME

## Golf Etiquette

*Unlike many sports, golf is played for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf. (USGA)*

- USGA Rules Apply
- Players are expected to know the rules. Lack of knowledge regarding a rule does not exempt the player from incurring appropriate penalties.
- Players are entitled to free relief from a burrowing animal hole, a cart path, and a tree, which has been staked or casual water. The player should determine the nearest point of relief.
- No practicing on the golf course or on the putting green of the hole already played, during league play.
  
- AT THE GOLF COURSE
  - ◆ Be at the golf course **20 minutes** prior to your tee time.
  - ◆ Check in at the first Tee Box, **10 minutes** prior to your tee time.
- ON THE TEE BOX
  - ◆ DO NOT pull golf carts onto the tee box.
- IN THE FAIRWAY
  - ◆ Safety First
    - Know where the other players are on the hole or the course (you are responsible for ensuring that your intended landing area or line of play is clear of other players)
  - ◆ Avoid damaging the course
    - Repair divots (dirt side down and step on the divot to ensure flatness)
  - ◆ Place your cart, either pull cart or riding cart, so that it is out of players' line of vision
- IN A BUNKER
  - ◆ Enter and Exit on the low side of the bunker
  - ◆ Rake your footprints from the bunker
  - ◆ Place rakes on the outside of the bunker, parallel with the line of play
- ON THE GREEN
  - ◆ Repair your ball mark
  - ◆ Avoid damaging the green
  - ◆ Don't stand on another player's line when putting
  - ◆ Remove ball from hole by using your hand, not a club
  - ◆ Take turns returning the flagstick to the hole
  - ◆ Replace flagstick so it is centered in the hole
  - ◆ Don't talk when someone is putting

- ◆ Don't walk or cast your shadow on another player's line of putt
- ◆ Don't stand opposite the line of putts
- ◆ Mark your ball by placing the ball mark behind the ball
- ◆ Carts are never allowed on the greens.

## READY GOLF

### READY GOLF MEANS:

- Be ready at the First Tee Box early & be ready to play.
- Tee off when ready -- no honors. Be sure those playing ahead of you are finished playing that hole and have left the green. ***Exception: On holes 2, 4, 5 & 9 (each one is 135 yards or more) you may tee off while the group ahead of you is on the green, as long as you do not believe that you can hit the green with your tee shot.***
- Be ready to hit when it is your turn
- Hit when ready in the fairway
- Putt out when ready -- no honors, continue putting, if appropriate, until holed out.
- **Record scores at the next tee.**

WALK-ONS -- If you **had not** previously signed up for the play date and you find that you can play, call the pro shop (913-890-1600) to see if there are any openings.

SCORE CARDS – Players pick up a scorecard, when you pay your green fee. **Print your first and last name at the top of the card, along with the date.** Keep track of your individual scores and putts for each hole. ***Update your scorecard at the next tee.*** At the end of play, total both your scores and number of putts, then sign it and get another player to attest to your scores. Add any information regarding the weekly game on the card. Then place your completed score card in the basket located in the Pro Shop, which is in the northeast corner of the pro shop.

## Tournament and Weekly Event Information

### WEEKLY EVENTS

We offer a diverse range of weekly events, catering to both recreational and competitive players of varying skill levels. Please refer to the calendar of events for the specific game scheduled for each week. A reminder of the upcoming event will be sent via email prior to the day of play, accompanied by results from the previous week.

Upon completion of your game, please submit your scorecard to the box located in the northeastern corner of the pro shop.

The men's and women's event winner will receive a prize of \$10.

Birdies and Chip-ins will receive \$5.

A Hole-in-One will be awarded a prize of \$50.

### **Credit to Account**

Winners will receive a credit to their account in the Pro-Shop which can be utilized towards greens fees, merchandise, or Club 27.

### **TOURNAMENTS**

The OP Par 3 league organizes two tournaments annually, followed by a luncheon at the Sykes/Lady lower patio. This year's dates will be:

\* October 7

### **Prize Distribution**

The first-place team will receive \$20 to each player, the second-place team will receive \$15 to each player, and the third-place team will receive \$10 to each player. Additionally, the winners of each men's and women's special events will receive a \$10 each.

### **Registration**

Registration for the tournaments is limited to 72 players. A waitlist will be maintained. Registration will be on an individual basis, and participants are welcome to form teams on the morning of the tournament.
